15 years of affordable energy

From Energy Trust's investment of \$1.5 billion in utility customer funds:



Nearly 660,000 sites transformed into energy efficient, healthy, comfortable and productive homes and businesses 13,000 clean energy systems generating renewable power from the sun, wind, water, geothermal heat and biopower



\$6.9 billion in savings over time on participant utility bills from their energy-efficiency and solar investments

20 million tons of carbon dioxide emissions kept out of our air, equal to removing 3.5 million cars from our roads for a year A clean energy power plant

607 average megawatts saved

121 aMW generated

52 million annual therms saved

Enough energy to power **564,000** homes and heat **100,000** homes for a year

Avoided **20** million tons of carbon dioxide

Energy Efficiency Offers to Limited Income Households

Savings Within Reach details

- Goal is to address the two main barriers for energy retrofits in moderate income households:
 - Affordability
 - Out-of-pocket expense
- Increased incentives paid directly to trade allies
- Served nearly 5,000 households since 2014



Savings Within Reach incentives

- Are paid directly to the program-approved participating trade ally
- Cannot exceed the cost of materials and installation
- Are offered instead of, not in addition to, other Energy Trust incentives
- Can be paired with on-bill financing



Savings Within Reach incentives

Energy-efficiency upgrade	Savings Within Reach incentive	
Attic insulation	\$0.50/sq. ft.	
Wall insulation	\$0.50/sq. ft.	
Floor insulation	\$0.40/sq. ft.	
Ductless heat pump	\$1,000	
Heat pump (replacing electric resistance heat)	\$1,000	
High-efficiency gas furnace	\$550	
Heat Pump Water Heater when replacing an existing electric water heater)	\$375	

Which customers qualify?

- Customer of participating Energy Trust utility
- Income as defined by the IRS income tax return
- Referral mechanism
 - If household income is below guidelines, customer may be eligible for free weatherization assistance services

Manufactured Homes Promotion

- Encouraging installation of heat pump technology
 - Ducted and ductless
- Increased incentive for manufactured homeowners through a small network of contractors offer a fixed price
- Launched in September 2018
 - Over 200 installations YTD
