*2025 was a year of growth, gratitude, and determination at Oregon Energy Fund.*

Across Oregon, families continued to face rising costs, unpredictable weather, and mounting financial strain. Yet thanks to the compassion and generosity of our donors, partners, and volunteers, we were able to provide critical support to Oregonians throughout the state, **helping keep 5,317 people in 2,242 households safe, warm, and stable.**

Behind each of those numbers is a story: a senior able to stay in their home through a harsh winter; a single parent who could keep the lights on while caring for a sick child; a neighbor who found stability after months of uncertainty. **Your support turned moments of crisis into renewed hope.**

This year, we also continued expanding our work beyond emergency assistance by helping households lower their energy use and costs through targeted efficiency projects.

**Together, we are not only preventing shutoffs, but building a more resilient, energy-secure Oregon for the future, one home at a time.**

# STORIES OF RESILIENCE: HOW EMERGENCY ENERGY ASSISTANCE MADE A DIFFERENCE

Every number in this report represents a person — a neighbor, parent, student, or elder working to hold their life together through hardship. These stories reflect the courage and perseverance of Oregonians who faced impossible choices and found relief, stability, and hope through your support. All names have been changed to protect client anonymity.

## DAVID'S STORY – PAYING IT FORWARD

For decades, David had a steady job, owned his home, and prided himself on being the one others could count on. But when his company downsized, his position was eliminated and his job search stretched on for more than a year. His savings dwindled, bills piled up, and before long, he received a notice that his power would be shut off.



*“I remember staring at that envelope and feeling this wave of disbelief,”* David says. *“I’d worked hard my whole life — I couldn’t believe I was in that position.”*

Oregon Energy Fund helped with his electric bill, giving him the stability he needed to get through until he found new work. *“It wasn’t just help,”* he says. *“It was a reminder that anyone can fall on hard times — and that we can lift each other back up.”*

## GLEN'S STORY – A VETERAN'S SECOND CHANCE

After serving in the Navy, Glen struggled to adjust to civilian life. A back injury limited his work options, and disability benefits barely covered rent and food. During a winter cold snap, he faced a heartbreaking choice: pay for warmth or groceries.



OEF stepped in quickly to help with his heating costs. *“I didn’t know where else to turn,”* Glen says. *“They treated me with respect, not judgment.”* With his immediate crisis resolved, Glen was able to get back to physical therapy and start part-time work again. *“It’s a relief knowing people still look out for veterans like me.”*

## MAYA'S STORY – BALANCING SCHOOL AND SURVIVAL

At 22, Maya juggled community college classes, two part-time jobs, and caring for her younger brother after their mother’s illness. When her hours were cut, she fell behind on the electric bill, and the threat of losing power made studying impossible.

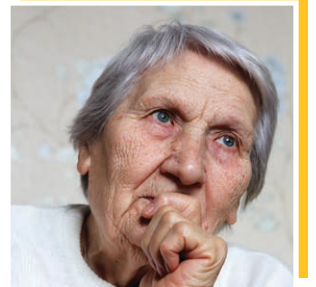


Oregon Energy Fund helped her with the balance and to arrange a payment plan to stay current. *“It meant I didn’t have to choose between tuition and heat,”* Maya says. *“I want my brother to see that we can make it through hard times and still move forward.”* She’s now studying to become a nurse and hopes to work in community health.

## EDNA'S STORY – CARRYING ON

Last year, we shared the story of Harold and Edna, a senior couple who turned to Oregon Energy Fund when rising costs left them facing a winter without heat. This year, Edna reached out again, this time on her own. After Harold’s passing, her Social Security income barely stretched far enough to cover both food and utilities, and a spike in her electric bill pushed her budget past the breaking point.



With OEF’s help, Edna stayed warm through the cold months and was able to remain in the home she and Harold built together. *“It’s been hard without him,”* she says. *“But I still feel his presence here. Knowing I can stay in our home means everything.”*

# OREGON ENERGY FUND'S ENERGY EFFICIENCY UPGRADES PROGRAM:

## BUILDING SUSTAINABLE, RESILIENT COMMUNITIES

Oregon Energy Fund's Energy Efficiency Program continues to grow, bringing lasting comfort and stability to families across Oregon. In partnership with **Habitat for Humanity** and **NW Natural**, we completed energy-efficiency upgrades at **Lindsay Lane**, a Habitat neighborhood of 19 homes built for working families.

We are now working to finish additional projects in the **Millennium** and **Cornerstone** Habitat for Humanity communities in **Aloha** and **Hillsboro**, continuing our commitment to improving comfort, safety, and affordability for Oregon families. These homes are receiving insulation and window upgrades, updated HVAC systems, high-efficiency water heaters, and other improvements that will help families save hundreds of dollars a year on energy and maintenance costs.

With these Habitat for Humanity projects nearing completion, OEF is also turning its attention to **Springwater Commons**, a 36-unit apartment community home to more than 250 residents — including over 180 children. Owned and managed by **Northwest Housing Alternatives**, one of Oregon's leading developers of not-for-profit low-income housing and a new nonprofit partner for OEF, **Springwater Commons** will receive high-efficiency HVAC systems, insulation, and other upgrades designed to lower utility costs and create healthier, more sustainable homes for years to come. Work in that community is slated to begin in 2026, so stay tuned for updates.

**Through these partnerships, Oregon Energy Fund is extending its mission beyond emergency relief, building resilience, sustainability, and stability for the communities we serve.**

## 7. DONOR ADVISED FUNDS (DAFs)

Donor Advised Funds are a flexible and tax-efficient way to give. If you have a DAF, you can recommend grants to Oregon Energy Fund, allowing your donation to make an immediate impact. Reach out to your fund manager or financial institution to direct support our way.

## 8. BEQUESTS

Leaving a legacy through a bequest is a powerful way to continue supporting OEF's mission for future generations. By including Oregon Energy Fund in your will or trust, you ensure that we can keep providing essential energy assistance to Oregonians in need. Speak with your estate planner or attorney to learn more about how to include OEF in your estate plans.

## 9. IRA REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTIONS (RMDs)

If you're 70½ or older, you can make tax-free contributions directly to Oregon Energy Fund from your IRA. This Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) counts toward your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) and can be a tax-efficient way to give. Contact your financial advisor to discuss making a direct gift to OEF from your IRA.

## 10. BENEFICIARY DESIGNATIONS

Consider designating Oregon Energy Fund as a beneficiary on your life insurance policy, IRA, or retirement plan. This simple step can make a lasting difference, ensuring your commitment to helping Oregonians endures well into the future. 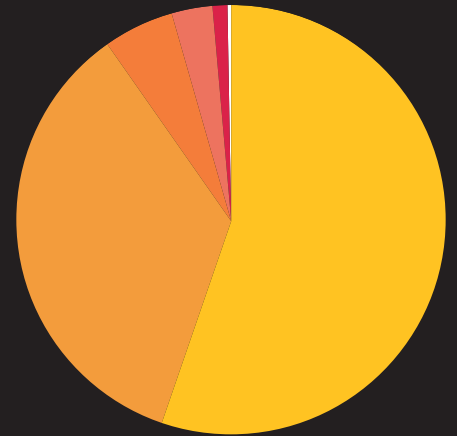

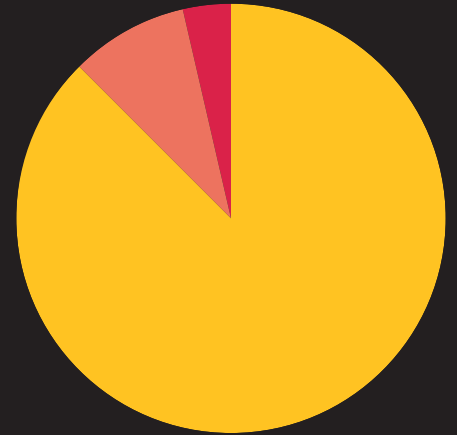
